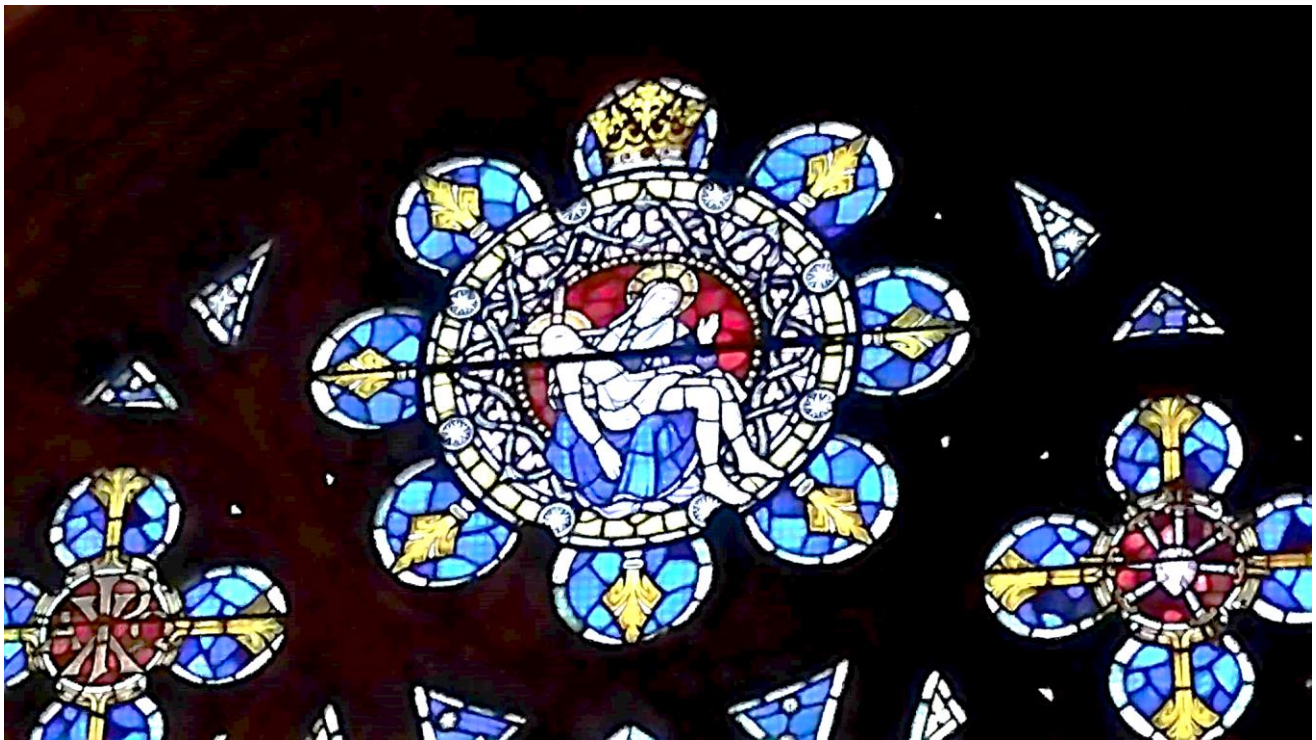

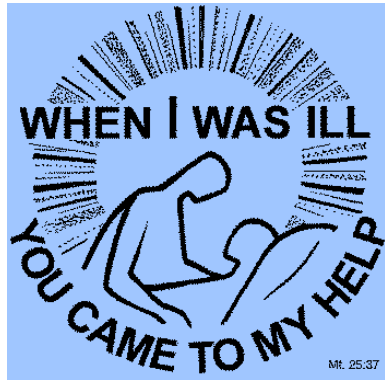

Although the Sunday Mass obligation is still suspended, please try to attend Mass whenever you can.



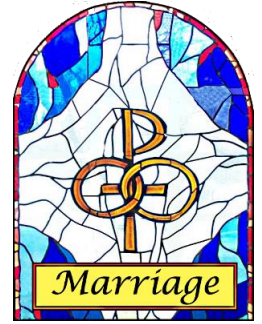
## SACRAMENT OF CONFESSION - SATURDAY
